- responds to short-term financial pressures & long-term financial sustainability

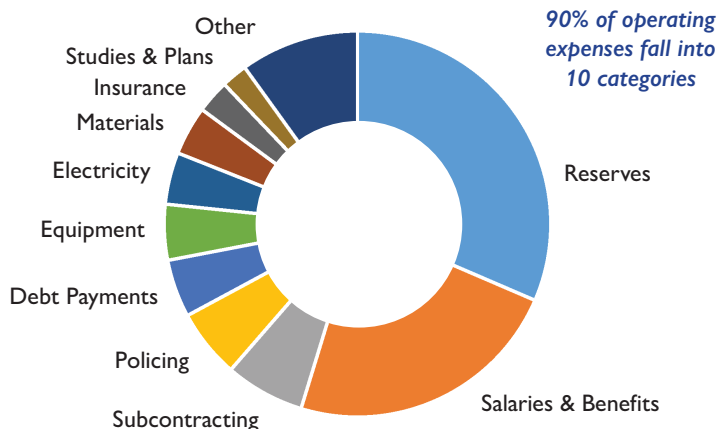
