MUNICIPALITY OF MIDDLESEX CENTRE

BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-049

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT OR REGULATE THE DISCHARGE OF GUNS AND OTHER FIREARMS, AIR-GUNS AND SPRING-GUNS, CROSS-BOWS OR LONG-BOWS

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, Section 119 authorizes that a local municipality may, for the purpose of public safety, prohibit or regulate the discharge of guns or other firearms, air-guns, spring-guns, cross-bows, long-bows or any other weapon;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the best interests of public safety to regulate the discharge of guns or other firearms in defined areas of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre enacts as a by-law as follows:

1. <u>Interpretation</u>

In this bylaw

- 1.1.1 "Council" means the Council of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre;
- 1.1.2 "Firearm" means any class or type of gun, spring gun, air gun, cross-bow or long-bow;
- 1.1.3 "Municipality" means the Municipality of Middlesex Centre;
- 1.1.4 "Officer" means:
 - i) any police officer,
 - ii) a By-law Enforcement Officer, Building Inspector or Chief Building Official as appointed by the Council of the Municipality;

2. **Prohibitions**

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any firearm within a restricted area, which shall include 300 metres along both sides of Longwoods Road, as set out in Schedule "A" attached to this By-law.

3. Exemptions

The following exemptions apply:

- 3.1 A farmer or his designate in the protection of his livestock, poultry or crops;
- 3.2 Archery classes for teaching purposes under the authority of a school board; and
- 3.3 Archery and/or cross-bow lessons, education or safety training provided within a building located at 2517 Gideon Drive, by an employee, director, agent or

contracted third-party of the business located at 2517 Gideon Drive, where no Federal Firearms Business Licence is required.

4. Severability

If a court of competent jurisdiction should declare any section or part of a section of this by-law to be invalid, such section or part of a section shall not be construed as having persuaded or influenced Council to pass the remainder of the by-law and it is hereby declared that the remainder of the by-law shall be valid and shall remain in force.

5. Enforcement

- 5.1 Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the *Provincial Offences Act* and as set out in Schedule "B", Set Fines.
- 5.2 The provisions of this By-law shall be enforced by an Officer.

6. **Effective Date**

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.

7. Repealed By-Laws

By-law 2001-048 is hereby repealed.
