

## Garden Ave, Wellington St, York St, Gideon Drive Reconstruction

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre will soon be starting a construction project in your area. This letter provides details about the project and important information on how construction may impact you.

## **Project Details**

## How will Construction Impact You?

**Street Access and Parking:** Your road will be closed periodically during construction. Driveway access will be maintained to the extent possible.

**Vibration – Protect Valuables:** Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.

**Privately Owned Sprinkler Systems, Landscaping or Fencing:** If you have a sprinkler system, landscaping, or fencing within the municipal right-of-way that conflicts with the construction project you will be required to remove such fencing at your expense, on to your own property. The Municipality will not accept any liability for damage to items within the municipal right-of-way.



**Garbage and Recycling Collection:** If your pick-up point is temporarily blocked by construction the contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling. Please mark your house number on your bins and pails to ensure their return.

**Tree Removal:** In the event of construction conflicts there may be a need for tree removals within municipal right-of-way.

**Manicured Lawns:** The contractor will restore all damaged manicured lawns resulting from the construction project. Sod and water will be applied by the Contractor to such affected locations. We encourage you to assist in the watering process.

**Mail Services:** Canada post will continue to deliver mail during construction. Temporary super boxes will be installed at locations yet to be determined. Canada Post will provide further notification and instructions for residents that may be impacted. The Post office will remain open during construction. It is recommended to access the post office on foot or from the north via Young St or Osborne St to York St.
