



HERITAGE PARK BARN QUILT

SUBMIT YOUR DESIGN IDEAS!

The barn at Ilderton's Heritage Park is being painted this summer.

As part of that face-lift, Middlesex Centre is inviting community members, school classes, businesses and community groups to submit designs for a barn quilt.

Designs will be voted on by the community in late July, and the selected design will be painted and installed on the barn in the fall.

Designing a Barn Quilt Block

- Your quilt block should be in a 1:1 ratio (a square or a diamond).
- You can draw it using whatever you like - from crayons to paints to computer programs.
- You can draw it on a piece of paper or digitally (the final design will be painted on a large 8 ft x 8 ft block).

What to include with your submission:

- Your quilt block design (a copy or a photo is fine if you are not submitting via the website)
- A brief description of why your design would be right for Ilderton
- Your name, your group's name (if applicable), and your contact information

Where to submit your design:

- Online at middlesexcentre.ca/barn-quilt
- Mail to the Municipality of Middlesex Centre at 10227 Ilderton Rd., Ilderton, ON, N0M 2A0. Mail your design early to allow time for delivery.
- Drop-off at the Komoka Wellness Centre Service Desk or the Ilderton or Coldstream Library Branches.

Designs need to arrive at the Middlesex Centre office by July 7.
