

## **Culvert Rehabilitation Notice**

March 26, 2025

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre will soon be starting a construction project in your area. This letter provides details about the project with important information on how construction may impact you.

## **Project Details**

**Location:** Culvert C-111 is located on Thirteen Mile Road between Prospect Hill Road

and Clarke Road.

**Schedule:** Tentative start date – April 7, 2025

Estimated completion – May 5, 2025

**Scope:** Repair and rehabilitation of the existing culvert.

**Contractor:** Vandenberk Construction Inc.

## **How will Construction Impact You?**

**Street Access and Parking:** Road closures are expected during construction only allowing local traffic to access their properties. A detour route will be in effect during construction with the appropriate signage to direct traffic.

**Vibration & Dust– Protect Valuables:** Construction equipment can cause vibrations and dust. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage. The contractor will monitor dust conditions and apply dust suppressants as required to minimize dust due to construction.

**Mail Services:** Canada Post will continue to deliver mail during construction. Canada Post will provide further notification and instructions for residents that may be impacted. Staff will provide temporary mailboxes for those that must be temporarily moved due to construction.

**Garbage and Recycling Collection:** If your pick-up point is temporarily blocked by construction the contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling.

**Manicured Lawns:** The contractor will restore all damaged manicured lawns resulting from the construction project. A mixture of seed and water will be applied by the municipality to such affected locations. We encourage you to assist in the watering process.



**Sprinklers, Flower Beds, Invisible Fences, and Private Infrastructure:** Residents are encouraged to remove any private infrastructure and items that may be inadvertently located in the municipal right of way. The contractor will not be responsible for or repair any private infrastructure damaged or removed as a result of this work.
